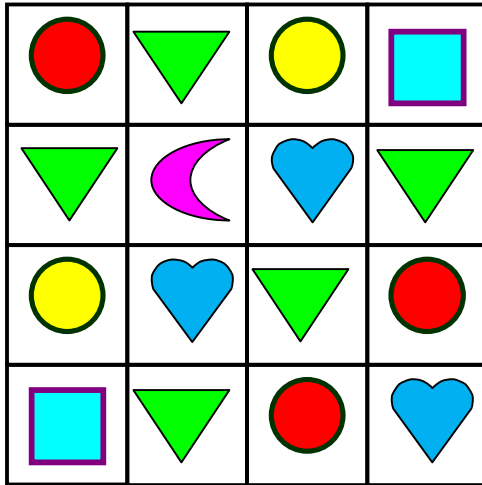





1. WORD SQUARE
